FEBRUARY 4, 2015
MINUTES

PRESENT: Jane Gray, Chris Kennedy, Monique Hebert, and Carl Nelson.

1. Chair Gray called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Public Hearing on 2015-16 Proposed Budget

Jane and Carl reviewed the proposed budget of \$666,776 and answered questions. The proposed warrant articles were also reviewed.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of six hundred sixty-six thousand, seven hundred seventy-six dollars (\$666,776) for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for school district officials and agents, and for the payment of the statutory obligations of the District. This article does not include appropriations voted in other warrant articles. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 3-0-0)

ARTICLE 6. To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of seven thousand dollars (\$7,000) to be placed in the Capital Reserve Fund (School Bus), established at the 1975 school district meeting, to be held in the custody of the Trustees of Trust Funds for the Town of Eaton. (Recommended by the School Board 3-0-0)

2. Approval of Minutes (1-5-15) – **Monique Hebert moved to approve the minutes of January 5, 2015. The motion was seconded by Chris Kennedy and passed 3-0-0.**
3. Business Affairs

 - B. Signing of Warrant and Budget Forms – The warrant and budget forms were signed as presented.
