

**TOWN OF EATON
PLANNING BOARD
March 18, 2015**

The Planning Board held their regular meeting on Wednesday, March 18, 2015. Present were Chairman Paul Savchick, Dennis Sullivan, Frank Holmes, Selectman Dick Fortin and Alternate Peter Klose. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Chairman Paul Savchick designated Peter Klose to act as a regular member for this meeting.

The Board discussed the schedule of meetings and it was the consensus of the Board to change the meetings to the second Wednesday of the month beginning April 8th.

Review of Minutes

The Board reviewed the Minutes of January 28, 2015. ***Frank Holmes made a motion, seconded by Dick Fortin, to accept the Minutes as written. Motion unanimously carried.***

Board of Selectmen Report

Dick Fortin gave an overview of the traffic and drainage issues in the Village raised by John Hartman and explained that the Board will be working on possible solutions.

Conservation Commission Report

Paul Savchick gave an update on the Conservation Commission, the on-going projects, proposed timber cuts and an overview on the status of the DES permit at Camp Waukeela.

**Public Hearing – Boundary Line Adjustment
Betsi & John Edge**

At 7:41 pm Paul Savchick reconvened the Public Hearing on an application from Betsi & John Edge for a boundary line adjustment for property located at 2399 Eaton Road (Tax Map U01 Lot 11). ***Frank Holmes made a motion, seconded by Peter Klose, to recess the Public Hearing until the next meeting. Motion unanimously carried.***

Master Plan

The Board discussed methods of presenting the Master Plan at Public Hearing. Paul Savchick explained that an on-screen tutorial session could be used with an explanation of why the Master Plan is in electronic format. Frank Holmes stated that notices should be posted indicating that copies are available and that residents should review the plan

and bring their questions to the Public Hearing. Dick Fortin suggested that the electronic version should also be made available.

Peter Klose made a motion, seconded by Dennis Sullivan, to adjourn the meeting. Motion unanimously carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:58 pm.
