ARTICLE #4 - Amendment #3 as proposed by the Planning Board to the Eaton Zoning Ordinance relative to Steep Slope Protection under Article V. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #8 - to raise and appropriate the sum of \$607,771 for general municipal operations. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #9 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$52,000 to be added to Capital Reserve funds. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #10 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$15,000 to be added to the Asphalt Expendable Trust Funds. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #11 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$25,000 for resurfacing of Class V gravel roads. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #12 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$32,360.22 for this year's grader lease payment. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #13 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,000 for the construction and construction engineering for the replacement of the Potter Road Bridge over Snow. **PASSED AS AMENDED**

ARTICLE #14 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 for Gibson Center for Senior Services, Inc. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #15 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$875 for Tri-County Community Action Program Inc. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #16 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500 Children Unlimited, Inc. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #17 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$850 for White Mountain Community Health Center. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #18 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,157 for Starting Point. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #19 - To raise and appropriate the sum of \$6,000 and enter into a one year contract with the Carroll County Sheriff's Department. **PASSED**

ARTICLE #20 - To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,799 to buy 2 electronic speed control signs. **PASSED AS AMENDED**

ARTICLE #21 - To authorize the Selectmen to appoint two (2) volunteer representatives from the Town to serve on the Carroll County Broadband "Communications District Planning Committee". **PASSED**

ARTICLE #22 – To urge that the New Hampshire General Court, which is obligated to redraw the maps of political districts within the state following the federal census, will ensure fair and effective representation of New Hampshire voters without gerrymandering; to urge the NH General Court to carry out the redistricting in a fair and transparent way through public meetings, not to favor a particular political party, to include communities of interest, and to minimize multi-seat districts. **PASSED**
